Principal's Corner

Parents, students, and staff, please help enforcing and complying with the following school rules:

Skateboards

-Students are prohibited from bringing or riding skateboards on school property.

Dress Code

-Clothing are to be free of holes or frays.

Shoes

-Shoes or sandals must be worn at all times.

-All shoes must fit appropriately (securely and appropriately fastened).
-Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes are strongly encouraged at grades PK-6, due to safety and outdoor activities.

-At grades PK-8, strapless, openheeled sandals/shoes are **not** allowed (i.e. sliders and "jandles").

 -Platform, high heel, or stacked sole shoes more than one inch high are not permitted at grades PK-4.
 -It is beneficial for the students to

wear tennis shoes or sports shoes to activities such as P.E./Athletics or recess.

 Steel toe shoes/boots aren't allowed.
 Shoes with wheels connected are not permitted.
