#### Nurse's Corner:

-Parents of 8th Grade Students Attending HEB Camp please make sure that Health and History is current. All medication will need to be checked in on Sunday, February 11, 2024, with luggage drop off. Students cannot possess medication of any kind, just like on school primuses.

-School rules state: if a child has a <u>fever 100.0 or</u> <u>greater, they must stay home and can only come</u> <u>to school after being fever free for a full **24**.</u>

hours without medication. If your child comes to school with a fever, they will be sent home. Watch for signs of flu symptoms: fever, chills, headache, body aches, fatigue or weakness, and nonproductive cough.

-Please send your children properly dressed to school so they will not be cold in the mornings or on cold days.

-If your child does need any over the counter medication, a parent must bring it in to the nurse and sign a release for the child to take the medication at school. Children are not allowed to bring any medication to school.

- -All Vision, Hearing, and Scoliosis screenings have been completed and referrals mailed home. If you received a referral on your student, please ensure it is returned promptly.
- -In addition, February is American Heart Month. Encourage at least one hour of heart pumping exercise and healthy diet. A diet should consist of fruits, vegetables, lean meats, and low or sugar free snacks.
