#### Nurse's Corner:

-Make sure that your student is drinking plenty of water when out in the heat to prevent dehydration. -According to the FDA and CDC the 2023 National Youth Tobacco Survey (NYTS) data revealed that "there was an increase in current overall tobacco product use among middle school students (4.5% to 6.6%) and multiple tobacco product use (1.5% to 2.5%)." (Birdley et al., 2023). Due to this increase I feel as a parent you should be aware of some warning signs associated vaping.

·Changes in behavior-increased mood swings, irritability, anxiety, impulsivity

·Frequent headaches/nausea

Use of unfamiliar/slang language-Dab/Dabbing- vaping marijuana oil, Boot- having someone else purchase vape/s, Nic Salts- nicotine based vape juice, Nic/Device/Mods/Cart/ Puff Bar- referring to vape pens or e-cigarettes, Clone- knock-off of an original vape device,

Chost/Dragon/Tornado – Types of vape tricks .Sweet/fruity/new smells without a known source

Unfamiliar chargers, coils, and/or batteries

On April 13, the Flour Bluff Junior High traveled to San Antonio for the TMSCA State Championship. I am proud to say that our Hornets are once again the State 5A Champion. For those keeping count that is 39 years in a row. Not only did we win Sweepstakes but we won all 3 team Math events and a very close second in Science. The win this year was the most dominating in memory. We beat the 2nd place team by over 1700 points, which is equivalent of not doing one of the 4 contests at all. Not only did they have the highest score in 5A they had the highest team score in the entire state by over 600 points. We won 1st place individual in all four 7th grade events (Number Sense, Calculator, General Math, and Science) and 1st place individual in 2 events (Number Sense and Calculator). I think the most impressive statistic is that we won 49 out of 60 top 10's in the Math events (that is 82% of all top 10's). Of special note please high five Kaitlyn Hu, Tom Su, Olivia Zuo, Stephen Jin, and Jack Provence who were all individual state champions in events.
