Welcome to the 2024-2025 School Year!
-Parents, please review and ensure that your child's health conditions are up to date. Please notify me immediately of any new health conditions that may impact their school day.
-ALL medication is to be signed into Nurse Mallory and have a Medication Release Form filled out by the parent/guardian NO EXCEPTIONS. Students are not allowed to possess ANY medication (prescription or over the counter, this includes but is not limited to ibuprofen, acetaminophen, eye drops, etc.) at any time.

*Exceptions for students with Asthma/Anaphylaxis/Diabetes who I have received written orders from their doctor for them to self-carry.

- -Vaccines Due NOW. If I show your student is not up to date on vaccines, they will not be able to start school on August 14th.
- *Per the Texas Department of State Health Services, all students must be up to date on shots before the first day of school, unless they have not turned 12 at the time school starts on August 14, 2024.
- *If you want to check vaccine status please stop by, call, or email me.
 - -Reminders:
 - *Fever (100.0°)- must stay home for 24-hours fever free without the use of medication.
- *Vomiting- must stay home for 24-hours vomiting free without the use of medication.
- *Diarrhea (2+ loose BM is considered diarrhea) must stay home for 24-hours diarrhea free without the use of medication.
