CLASS OF 2031

- Need 26 credits to graduate from high school
- Technology credit is no longer required for graduation
- Professional Communication (Speech) credit is no longer required for graduation

Students will learn more about College, Career, or Military Readiness (CCMR) through their 7th grade Career & College Exploration course (required)

WHAT IS A HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT?

- A **CREDIT** is what you earn after you have finished a high school level course. Grades below 70 are considered failing and no credit will be given. Grade will be averaged into Grade Point Average (GPA). Each semester is worth a ½ (.5) credit. You will be required to complete a certain number of credits to graduate.
- Grade Weighted Courses will earn 10 additional points to students' GPA per semester.
- A TRANSCRIPT/ACADEMIC RECORD is an official and legal copy of a student's grades reflecting all course grades including failed courses.
