

-Please review the 2025-2026 Health and Medical History you completed during registration to ensure it is accurate. Please notify me immediately of any new health conditions that may have an impact on your child's school day.

-ALL medication is to be brought in by a parent or guardian and must be unexpired in the original container. All prescription medications are required to be in a prescription bottle and meeting all requirements of the prescription label.

-All EpiPens and all inhalers must be in the box with the prescription label on it and unexpired.

-Reminders: Fever (100.0°)-must stay home for 24-hours fever free without the use of medication.

Vomiting-must stay home for 24-hours vomiting free without the use of medication. Diarrhea (2+ loose BM is considered diarrhea)-must stay home for 24-hours diarrhea free without the use of medication.
