

Nurse's Corner:

- The 25-26 Notice of Consent for School Health-Related Services consent form is required to be completed by the parent. If this form is not completed, the school nurse will be unable to see your child for any reason and a call will be placed home.
- State Required Vision, Hearing, and Spinal Screenings will take place starting in October.
- *If the 25-26 Notice of Consent for School Health-Related Services consent form is not completed your student will not be screened and a referral will be sent home.
- *If your child has a referral sent home you will have to take your child to complete the state-required screenings.
- Parents/Guardians please ensure that the nurse is aware if your student has a health condition. If your student has Asthma, Anaphylaxis, Seizures, or Diabetes the plan and medication (if any) are needed ASAP. Per the student handbook students are NOT allowed to possess medication (prescription or over the counter) of any kind.
- *Exception: A student with asthma or severe allergic reaction (anaphylaxis) may possess and use prescribed asthma or anaphylaxis medication at school or school-related events only if he or she has written authorization from his or her parent and a physician or other licensed health-care provider.
- This school year has been full of germs and illness. Please be mindful that October is the "official" start of flu season. It is encouraged to continue good hygiene practices (i.e., proper hand hygiene, covering mouth with elbow when coughing/sneezing, and staying home when feeling ill).
- *Reminder- Fever (100.0), vomiting, and diarrhea require a student to stay home for 24 hours without the use of medication.
- Medications, care plans, and/or medical supplies may be dropped off by a Parent/Guardian at any time, please call the campus nurse, at 361-694-9388, with any questions.
