- Vision and Hearing Screenings have been completed. Referral letters are currently being sent out for those students who need a referral to a provider. Please have any referral completed and provide documentation as soon as possible.
 - Spinal Screenings will be completed December 9th - 12th for 7th grade females and 8th grade males during P.E./LOTC classes for all students without a current 2025-2026 sports physical on file with the athletics department.
 - Flu season has started once again. Helpful tips to prevent getting ill include:
Getting the flu vaccination, cover your mouth and nose with your arm when sneezing/coughing, frequently wash hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds, be a role model, and practice proper hand hygiene yourself.
 - If you are sick, please stay home from school and work, and stay away from others until you are better. For more information about the flu please visit <https://www.cdc.gov/flu>.
 - Protocol to return to school from illness is overall improvement in symptoms, fever (100.0), vomiting, and diarrhea free without the use of medications for 24 hours.
 - Reminder: Students are not allowed to bring any medications to school under any circumstances. Parents are required to bring all medication in and fill out a medication administration form and provide all doctor's paperwork for self-carry medications.
