Nurse's Corner:

-It is Flu Season, please keep your student home if they are showing signs and symptoms of illness, fever, chills, headache, body aches, fatigue or weakness, and nonproductive cough.

-School rules state: if a child has a fever (100.0 or greater), they must stay home and can only come to school after being fever free for a full 24 hours without medication. If your child comes to school with a fever, they will be sent home.

-Please send your children properly dressed to school so they will not be cold in the mornings or on cold days.

-If your child does need any over the counter medication, a parent must bring it into the nurse and sign a release for the child to take the medication at school. Students are not allowed to bring any medication to school.

-All Vision, Hearing, and Scoliosis screenings have been completed and referrals mailed home. If you receive a health referral on your student, please ensure it is returned promptly.

-In addition, February is American Heart Month. Encourage at least one hour of heart pumping exercise and healthy diet. A diet should consist of fruits, vegetables, lean meats, and low or sugar free snacks.
