What is a High School Credit?

- A **CREDIT** is what you earn after you have successfully finished a course. Grades below 70 are considered failing and no credit will be given. The grade will be averaged into Grade Point Average (GPA). Each semester is worth a $\frac{1}{2}$ (.5) credit. You will be required to complete a certain number of credits to graduate.
- Grade Weighted Courses will earn 10 additional points to students' **GPA** per semester.
- A **TRANSCRIPT/ACADEMIC RECORD** is an official and legal copy of a student's grades reflecting **all** course grades including failed courses.

Important Things to Know About Attendance

- State law requires that a student between the ages of 6 and 19 attend school.
- Students may be denied credit if they are not in attendance in a class 90% of the time the class is offered.
