7<sup>th</sup> Writing- May 4<sup>th</sup>

8<sup>th</sup> Science - May 11<sup>th</sup>

8<sup>th</sup> Social Studies- May 12<sup>th</sup>

7<sup>th</sup> Reading- May 13<sup>th</sup>

8<sup>th</sup> Reading- May 18<sup>th</sup>

7<sup>th</sup> Math/Algebra EOC- May 19<sup>th</sup>

8<sup>th</sup> Math- May 20<sup>th</sup>

### **Testing Location and Safety Guidelines**

- All state assessments will occur on campus.
- Non-testing students will receive asynchronous assignments when STAAR testing occurs.
- Only students who are testing will be on campus for the day. All students NOT testing will receive asynchronous assignments, allowing for social distancing.
- Example: If your student is a 7<sup>th</sup> grader, they will come up to campus on May 13<sup>th</sup> for the 7<sup>th</sup> grade Reading assessment. If your student is an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, they will stay home on May 13<sup>th</sup> and complete asynchronous assignments.

### **Virtual Students**

- Parents and guardians may feel that for health reasons sending your virtual student to campus to test is not an option.
- Virtual students will have a choice of coming to the campus to test or not.
- We highly encourage ALL students to come to campus to test.

### **Requirement for passing STAAR End of Course (EOC) assessments (Algebra)**
